- Performs an enterprise wide information security risk assessment annually for the Bank.
- Monitor the Bank's third party relationships including: vendor assessment forms, external assessment reports (SAS70 or SSAE 16) for critical vendors. Provides reports to the Bank's Information Technology Oversight Committee (ITOC) as needed.
- Monitors compliance with security policies and procedures for all information technology systems throughout the organization including: adequate incidence response procedures are in place to react to security violations within critical systems.
- Performs project risk assessments as required based on project specifications.
- Reviews security logs and changes to ensure administration and access to systems are appropriate and secure.
- Develops and coordinates security training programs for employees. Provides ongoing security awareness training to management and all employees.
