ISACA Project Spotlight – Security Harmony

The role of the information security manager has evolved over the past few years from an essentially IT-focused role to that of a business/IT hybrid. At the same time, numerous security standards, codes of practices, methodologies, etc., have been developed and published, all with the purpose of providing some level of direction or support for security objectives.

The purpose of this technical study is to provide the CISM holder with a guide to the better-known and more widely available information security documents. In all, more than 17 standards/guidance were evaluated across a number of criteria, enabling information security managers to identify those that may be most appropriate for improving their own skills and knowledge or most useful within their organizations.

The full study includes insights learned from a global survey of CISM's. The results are targeted for release in the first quarter of 2005.
